



## John "Doug" Douglas Moore

John Douglas Moore, 71, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away on Tuesday, March 24, 2026.

Born on January 23, 1955, in Vallejo, California, Doug was the son of John D. and Bonnie (Dailey) Moore. He attended elementary and middle school in Muskogee before moving to Barlow, Kentucky, where he attended school through the 11th grade. These two communities formed the backdrop of a life defined by hard work and a steady, capable nature.

In the fall of 1981, Doug and Kelli began their life together in Muskogee. Over the next 44 years, they built a life full of shared memories and a family that remained his greatest priority.

Doug was a man who truly enjoyed the satisfaction of working with his hands. He was preceded in death by his parents, John D. and Bonnie Moore; and his daughter, Candy Lee Moore.
