John Wesley Guthrie, 77, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, February 19, 2013 in Tulsa with his family at his side. He was born December 28, 1935 in Muskogee to Virgil Frank Guthrie and Bertha Perry Guthrie. John grew up in the Wainwright area where he attended school graduating in 1955.
