Joseph John Skeith III, 95, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, September 4, 2012 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He was born September 5, 1916 in Arma, Kansas to Joseph John Skeith II and Katherine Fox Skeith and grew up in Henryetta, Oklahoma.
