Joyce Faye Walker Fredrick Parker Stine, age 89, of Oktaha, Oklahoma, died on Thursday, September 12, 2024 in Oktaha, Oklahoma. She was born on January 21, 1935 in Oktaha, Oklahoma in a two room house down in the bottom, the second child born to Buster and Allie Walker. She lived in the same area most of her life, and passed in her own home on Thursday, September 12, 2024, just a short distance from where she was born. Joyce attended Oktaha School and graduated as valedictorian, at the age of 16, having skipped two grades. She had to wait until she was 17 before she could begin her job at Southwestern Bell Telephone with her good friend and later sister-in-law, Reta Tidwell.

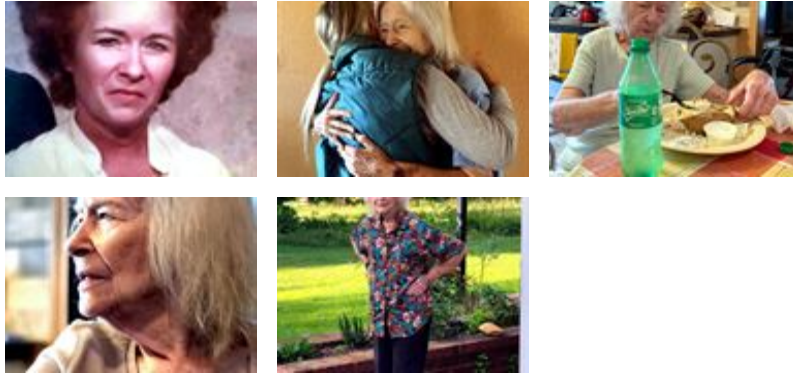
