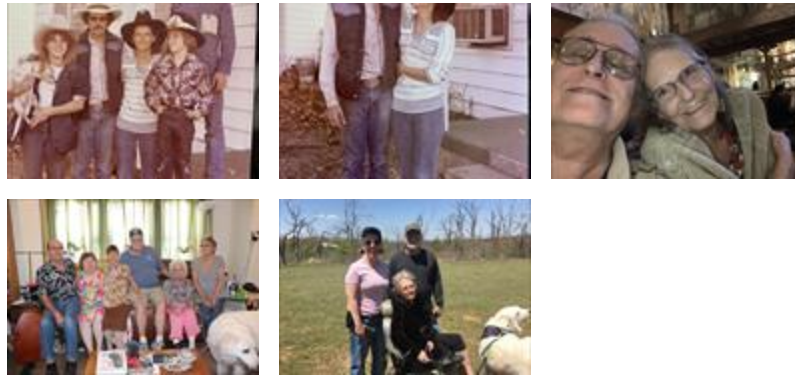
“ Dear mom,

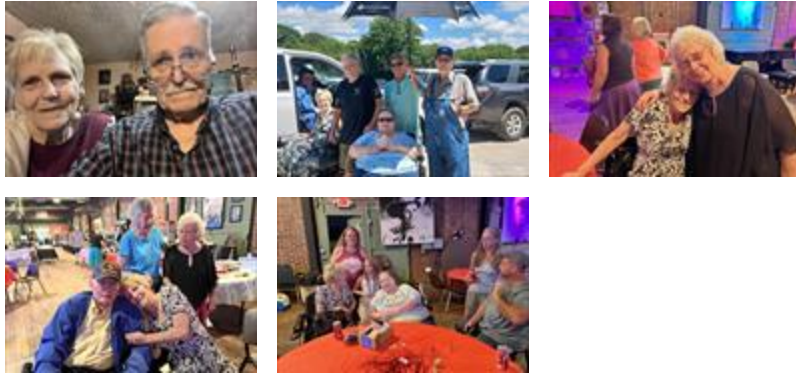
