June Ann Dotson, 79, of Muskogee, died December 22, 2018, at her home. She was born on May 4, 1939 in Muskogee, Oklahoma to Clyde and Shirley Frisby. The family moved to Shawnee, Oklahoma in 1948 where her parents attended Oklahoma Baptist University. June attended and graduated from Shawnee High School in 1957. Following her return to Muskogee in 1963 she graduated from Northeastern State College in 1972 with a Master's Degree in Education. June subsequently taught at Bacone College, Oktaha and Warner High Schools. She was also employed as a social worker by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services in Muskogee, retiring in 2001.

June's passion was teaching her Bible Study Class, Higher Ground, at the First Baptist Church in Muskogee, where she was actively involved in Women's Missionary Union, mission trips to Mexico, and Vacation Bible Schools. She loved studying the Bible and spent hours preparing Bible study lessons.
