



## Kathleen Ann Eisermann

September 29, 1945 - December 15, 2024

Kathleen Ann Eisermann, cherished mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away on December 15, 2024, in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Born to Ralph and Olive Ent on September 29, 1945, in the quaint town of Horton, Kansas, Kathleen's early life was marked by a spirited blend of small-town values and a strong sense of family.

She graduated from high school in Whiting, Kansas, and further honed her skills at a trade school in Atchison, Kansas. In 1966, she wed James Charles Hahn and embraced motherhood with the birth of her two children, Alvin Leroy Hahn and Ann Michelle Hahn (Mariano).

Kathleen's career with the Department of Veterans Affairs at the Colmery-O'Neil Medical Center began in 1979, however due to a new position at the Jack C. Montgomery VA Medical Center in Muskogee, OK she moved to Vian in 1985. In 2000, seeking proximity to the Muskogee VA hospital and eager to reduce her commute, she settled in Muskogee, where she continued her dedicated service until her retirement in 2019 from the Jack C. Montgomery VA Medical Center. Notably proud of her tenure, she always emphasized the inclusion of that extra half-year, marking 39.5 years of commitment.

Retirement brought new joys as Kathleen delighted in the company of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Her passions included family dinners

out and an unabashed love for shopping, each outing filled with laughter and joy.

Preceded in death by her parents, Ralph and Olive; and brothers, Gary and Wayne Ent.

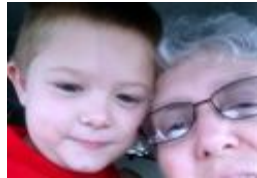

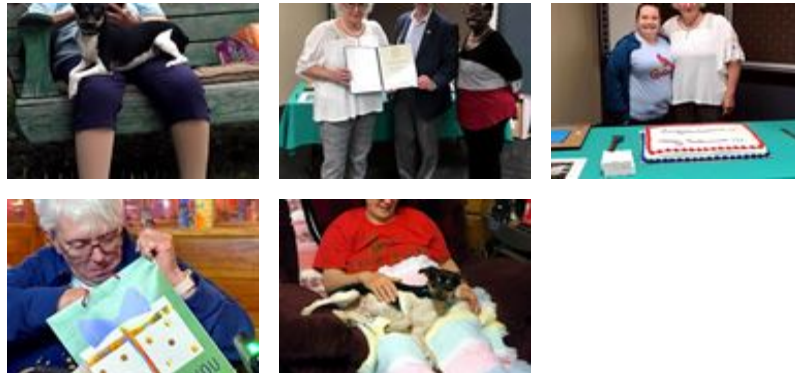
