Kathy became a mother to three beautiful children, Shonika "Cocoa", TaByas and Stephanie. She loved them dearly and began to think about becoming a teacher. She continued her work as a beautician and a secretary to support her family. In 1992 she married Ronnie Anderson and together they grew in their faith. Like her mother, Kathy taught her family about love, God, and praying. She and her husband would go on to become licensed ordained Elders. She was known as a "prayer warrior" praying for people all over the world.

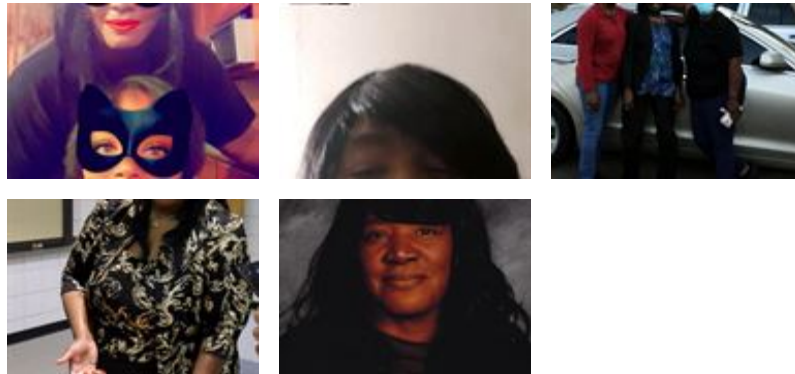
