



## Kenneth "Ken" R. Dotson

October 11, 1935 - August 30, 2017

Kenneth "Ken" Dotson, 81, of Denver, Colorado entered Heavens gates on Wednesday, August 30, 2017. He was born on October 11, 1935 to Oattie and Nina (Montgomery) Dotson in Huntsville, Arkansas. He grew up and attended Muskogee Public Schools and graduated with the class of 1957.

He married the love of his life, Shirley Minnick, on June 8, 1957 in Fort Gibson, OK at the home of her parents. Together they shared over 60 years of life, friendship, and marriage.
