January 8, 1941 - January 2, 2016

Ken O. Hill, 74, of Stigler, Oklahoma passed away on January 2, 2016 after a courageous battle with cancer. He was born January 8th, 1941, and at age three he was adopted by Melvin Rob Hill and Geneva Mae Hill. He was raised in Genoa, Colorado. Ken attended Genoa schools and graduated in 1958. After graduating he started his career as an electrical lineman at Mountain View Electrical Co. in Limon, Colorado. In 1964 he married Connie Jo Skinner of the same town. In 1965 he moved to Colorado Springs, Colorado where he worked for the Fountain Power Company until 1969, when he transferred to the Air Force Academy to work as a lineman. In 1968 his son Tharyn Lynn was born, later joined by his other son Trayce Landon in 1971. In 1973 the family moved to Muskogee, Ok where Kenneth worked for SWPA-GRDA. Ken and his family resided on a small farm in Ft. Gibson where both his sons graduated in Ft. Gibson, Ok. After their divorce in 1995 Ken moved to Warner, Ok. and later to Stigler, Ok. In September 2012 he married Maxine where they continued to live in Stigler, Ok. until his departure to heaven.

Ken was preceded in death by his parents Melvin and Geneva Hill of Colorado. He is survived by his wife Maxine Hill of the home; brother, Jim Bruder and wife Patti of Colorado; sister, Kathy Gallagher of Wichita, Kansas . 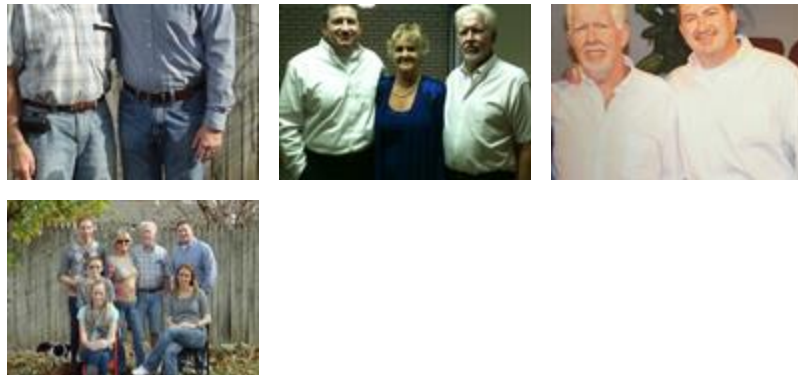
