

## Kenneth D. Webb

December 19, 1930 - March 10, 2025

Kenneth Duane Webb, 94 years and 80 days old, left his earth hand in hand with his God on March 10, 2025. Ken was born on December 19, 1930 in Anthony, Kansas to Walter and Evelyn Webb. He graduated from Wakita High School and married his one true love, Lois Mitchell, on October 8, 1950. He then received an associate's degree in accounting from Northern Oklahoma Junior College. After a few relocations, he landed in Muskogee, in 1957, where he went to work for the Oklahoma Cushion Company, a subsidiary of H. B. Egan Manufacturing Company. After several years, he was promoted to Sr. Vice President and General Manager of H. B. Egan Co., later named Bridgeport Products of Chicago, where he eventually retired from. Ken then spent a few years working with his friend, Glen Smith, at his oil company as well as a few fast-food businesses.

Kenneth was an avid member of the First United Methodist Church for nearly 70 years and served his church every chance he got. He built homes for Habitat for Humanity, taught Sunday school for many years, sang in the choir, and worked with the MYF youth group. He and his wife of 67 years gave their hearts and soul to his church and loved every minute of it. To his last breath he professed his love for his First United Methodist Church family and his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He commented just last week that "God was ready for him" and we believe he had that from a very reliable source!

Ken loved his Muskogee Roughers, his OSU Cowboys, his family, and did we mention his golf buddies? He made memory after memory at both Muskogee Country Club and Eagle Crest Country Club where he professed to at least 9 separate hole-in-ones. We are working on identifying those witnesses!!!

Ken will be missed no doubt by numerous friends and acquaintances he has made, both young and old, and his family; sons, Mike and Greg and their wives, Dale and Patti; granddaughter, Jennifer; and great-granddaughter, Makinley; grandsons, Eric and Taylor, his much loved 96 year old sister, Louise Rapp; and sister-in-law, Phyllis Mitchell; and a bunch of cousins, nephews, and nieces.

He was preceded in death by several family members but none more precious to him than his loving wife, Lois. She also was a devoted member of First Methodist Church and had a special love for all the children that came through its doors.

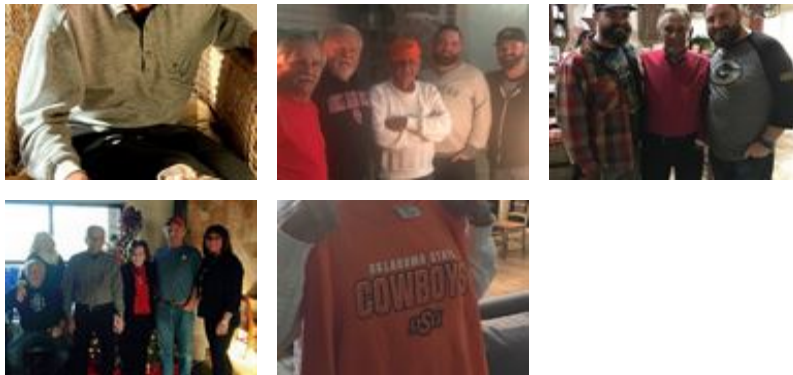
