



## Kirk Douglas Munzenrider

Kirk Douglas Munzenrider, 63, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away peacefully on Monday, May 9, 2016. He was born March 30, 1953, in Muskogee to Adolph "Ace" Henry and Odette (Thomas) Munzenrider. He grew up and attended the public schools in Braggs and graduated with the class of 1971. After high school graduation, Kirk furthered his education by attending the Bill Willis Skill Center in Tahlequah, from which he received a welding certification.

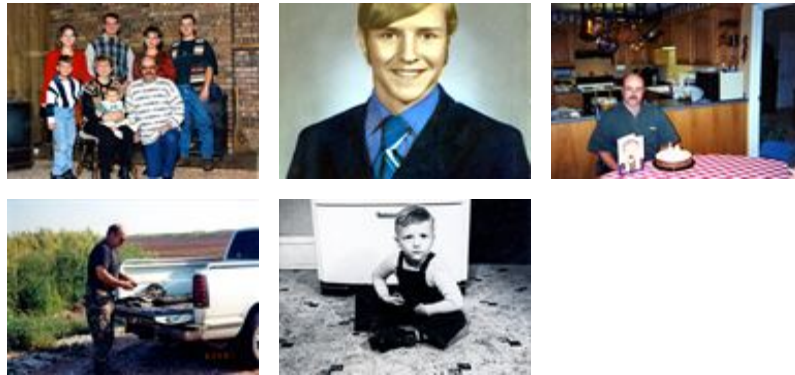
