Larry Littlebird Vaughn was born September 7, 1945 in Stilwell, OK to Wallace and Mary (Tehee) Vaughn. Larry passed away October 23, 2020 at the age of 75. He attended schools in Stilwell, OK and Chicago, IL. He graduated high school in Stilwell and then attended OSU Okmulgee. After working as a truck driver for a while, Larry began his vocation of maintenance mechanic at H.B. Egan Manufacturing in Muskogee, OK and remained there until he retired.
