



## Lawrence "Larry" R. Lowrance

November 24, 1925 - January 30, 2015

Lawrence "Larry" Reginald Lowrance, 89, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Friday, January 30, 2015. He was born November 24, 1925 in Oktaha, Oklahoma to William Filo Lowrance and Maggie Mae Hiner Lowrance. Larry grew up in Boynton, Oklahoma where he attended school. His high school years were spent at Pineville High School in Longview, Texas where he graduated and was a football letterman. After completing his high school studies, he proudly served his country as a member of the Army Air Corp during WWII in the Pacific Theatre. He later received an Honorable discharge. 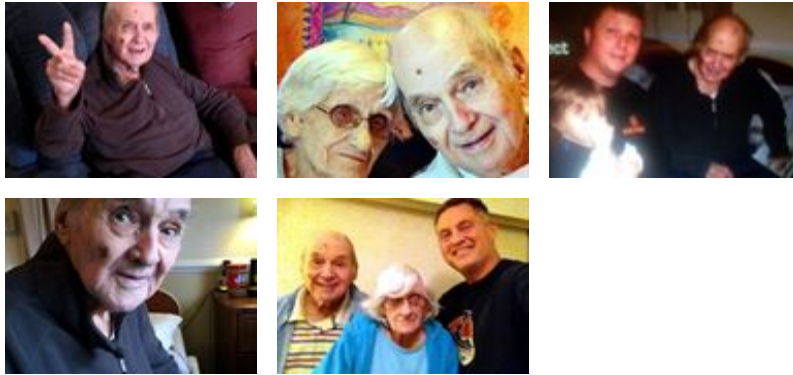
