Leroy Hathcoat passed away Sunday, August 20, 2023, at the age of seventy-five. He was born February 5, 1948 in Wagoner, Oklahoma. His parents were Joseph Louie and Mildred Mansker Hathcoat. Leroy grew up in Muskogee, Oklahoma where he attended public schools. He also attended Connors State College.

Leroy joined the United State Marine Corps and was wounded while serving in the Vietnam War. He was honorably discharged with the rank of Sergeant. He held numerous jobs during his life. He was a prison guard at McAlester State Prison, clerical help at the Veterans Administration Hospital, built fences, painted homes and businesses, and worked security for several companies.

He along with his cousin, Butch Hathcoat, served in the honor guard, honoring our deceased veterans. He took great pride in doing this.

Leroy liked to fish, hunt, and tried his hand at golf. After his health began to fail, he enjoyed watching all types of nature programs. He especially enjoyed a good western, a series or a movie. It didn't matter if he had seen it time and time again.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
