Lois P. Hamby, 102 years of age of Muskogee, went to be with her Lord on Saturday evening, March 28, 2015, surrounded by her loving family. 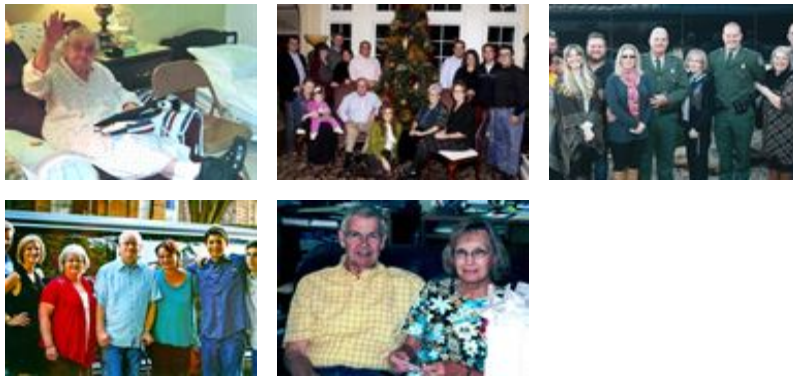
