A Memorial Service will be held for Lola May Miller at 11:00 a.m., Saturday, November 15, 2014 at Cedarlawn Memorial Park in Sherman, Texas. Lola was cared for by family in her home the past few months, passing away on Nov. 3, 2014. She was born in Sherman, TX to Lloyd Sutherland and Millie May Coates Sutherland on June 23, 1936, and has one sister, Peggy Davis in Ft. Worth TX. Lola grew up in Denison, TX where she married Martin L. Worthington Jr., and had two children, LeAnne and Martin III. Lola was widowed in 1958 when Martin drowned. She later married James R. McGee, the father of Pam, Tara, and Jimmy McGee. After a year of army life in Kansas, they returned to Denison, where she worked for the Katy Railroad, and had their daughter, Cynthia. Much later, when living in Porum, OK their last child, Maryi, was born. James, whom everyone called Jim, and Lola moved to Muskogee, OK and became Realtors. During this time Lola, earned her Associates Degree at Connors State College. Sadly, Lola was widowed again in 1985 when Jim passed away, unexpectedly, from leukemia. With her last child, Maryi, only age 10, Lola moved to her hometown of Denison, returned to college earned her Bachelor's Degree in Social Work at E.T.S.U. and Masters in Counseling and Psychology at the University of Texas., specializing in Child Psychology . In 2012 a fall at work forced her into retirement. The last several years of Lola's life, she cared for her own mother until her passing in 2013 at age 98. Lola served as the pianist at every church she was a member over her lifetime. Lola deeply loved her children, and

adored her 14 grandchildren and 7 great- grandchildren.
