We still kept in touch with Mae until a few years ago. She was my Moms good friend too.

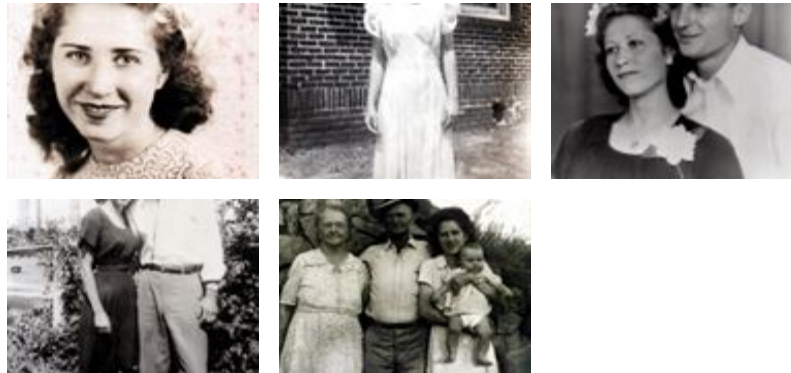
