Luke Tyler Dennis, 29, of Muskogee, went to his Heavenly home on October 13, 2018. He was born January 22, 1989 in Muskogee, the son of Rickey and Catherine (Cramp) Dennis. Luke accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and was baptized at the age of six at Southeast Baptist Church. He attended St. Joseph Catholic School, Alice Robertson Junior High, and graduated from Muskogee High School in 2007. He attended Northeastern State University and majored in organismic biology.

Luke was an accomplished musician and loved to play guitar. He was a featured player in the high school band, member of the jazz band, and enjoyed playing classical and alternative rock. He played at Muskogee First Baptist Church during worship and attended Falls Creek to play worship music for the camp. Luke was an avid golfer from the age of twelve and was a member of both the high school golf team and Junior PGA. He shared this hobby with his dad and Uncle Larry. His younger years included Knothole baseball, Cub Scouts, and annual trips with his mother to California to visit his grandmother.

Luke started mowing lawns with his dad while in high school, although he had many other jobs through college and beyond, he came back to what he enjoyed the most and that was making a lawn or a flower garden look beautiful. Luke managed and owned his own business, LTD Lawn and Landscape, and took great pride in his work. He got a helping hand from his dad. He talked a lot about how much he enjoyed his work and having his own

business. Many of his customers even became great friends. He spent a lot of time with his parents and ate dinner with them as often as he could. He was devoted to his longtime girlfriend, Felicia, and enjoyed traveling with her and her family, and was especially close with her dad, Emmett Sharp. Luke still loved playing music with his friends when he got the chance.

He will be remembered for his kind heart, smile, generosity, and the love he showed to those he cared about. Luke enjoyed being around people especially, his big brothers. He was always ready to do a favor or lend a helping hand whenever needed.

Luke was preceded in death by his maternal grandmother, Jean Uren; paternal grandparents, Dale and Margaret Dennis.

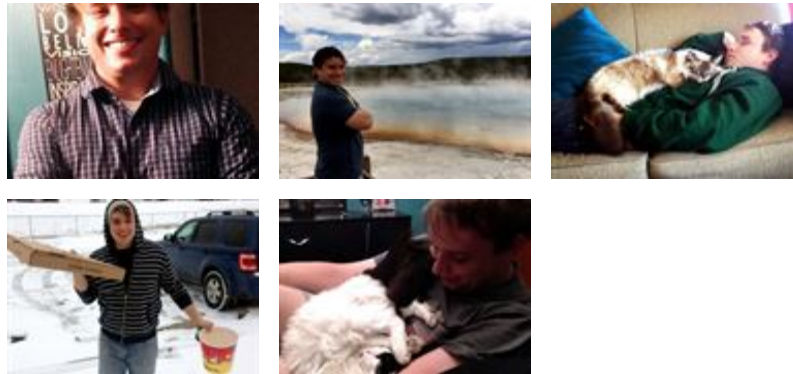
