Mack A. Terrapin, Sr., 83, of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma passed away Thursday, December 15, 2016. He was born June 30, 1933 to John and Irene Terrapin in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. He attended Muskogee High School where he played on the State Champion Football Team in 1950-1951.

He served in the United States Army during the Korean War, and received an honorable discharge to the United States Army Reserve in 1955. Mack married Dolores Sikes on April 2, 1980 in Pryor, Oklahoma. They shared 36 happy years of life and marriage together.

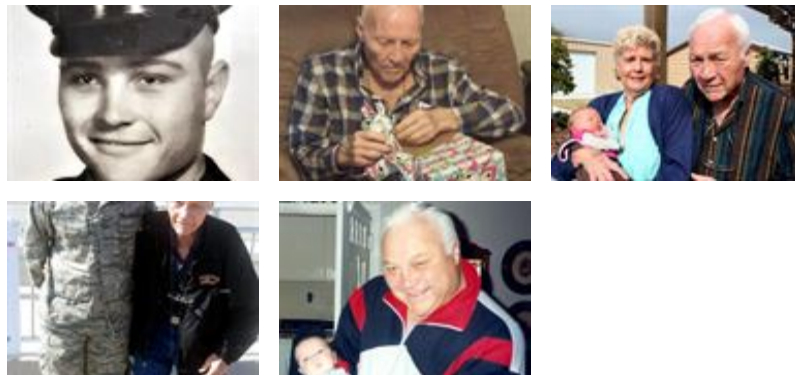
