MARGIE HOOG OBITUARY

Born January 3, 1922, Margie Dorene Kuykendall was the second in a line of 4 children born to Walter A. Kuykendall and Mattie Eleanor Edwards Kuykendall. She was raised in Shawnee Oklahoma and graduated from Shawnee High School. She then completed Draughon's Business College before coming to Muskogee in 1939. Soon after coming to Muskogee she met Lynn L. Hoog. They married in November of 1940. The first of two sons, Jeffery Lynn Hoog, was born November 5, 1941. For several years, Margie took care of Jeff while Lynn was in the Service. On June 7, 1947, after Lynn was discharged from the Navy, their second son, Gregory Eugene Hoog was born. Margie was a housewife until Lynn's death in 1968. She then started working for Floyd Perryman Concrete Co. in Muskogee where she worked until her retirement in 1980. After retiring, she lived in the family home until moving into Country Gardens Assisted Living in 2012. She loved living there and enjoyed the company of several close friends.

Margie was preceded in death by her husband, Lynn Hoog; son, Jeff Hoog; father, Walter Kuykendall; mother, Mattie Kuykendall; sister, Evelyn Flusche; brother, Edward Kuykendall; and grandson, Steven Hoog.
