Marjorie (Margie) Anne Weddle Bowman was born on March 2nd, 1961 at the Muskogee Baptist Hospital. Her faith became sight on December 28th, 2021. Margie attended grade school in Muskogee until moving to Wagoner in 5th grade. She lived on Lake Fort Gibson with her family. She attended Wagoner Public Schools and was a member of the High School Band and Stage Band. She enjoyed playing the flute, trombone and piano.

After graduation in 1979, Margie attended Oklahoma Baptist University graduating in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in Music Education with Vocal Emphasis. She was active in Bisonettes and OBU Chorale, singing at the Crystal Cathedral in California and studying abroad in Germany.

Margie married Paul Bowman on May 24, 1986 at First Baptist Church,

Muskogee. They shared in a lifetime of ministry, while Paul served at several Baptist churches in Tennessee, Missouri, Texas and Oklahoma. She served as a Sunday school teacher, active in the church choir, handbell choir and participated on numerous mission trips. She also shared her talents as soloist at church services, funerals and weddings. Margie will always be remembered as a wonderful wife, mother, educator and partner in Paul's ministry.

Margie's God given talents were expressed through tutoring many students, a "Parents As Teachers" program, teaching private voice and piano lessons, and public school music teacher. Her home was full of love, laughter, good food and family. Margie was devoted to her family. Friends were always welcome and made to feel like family.

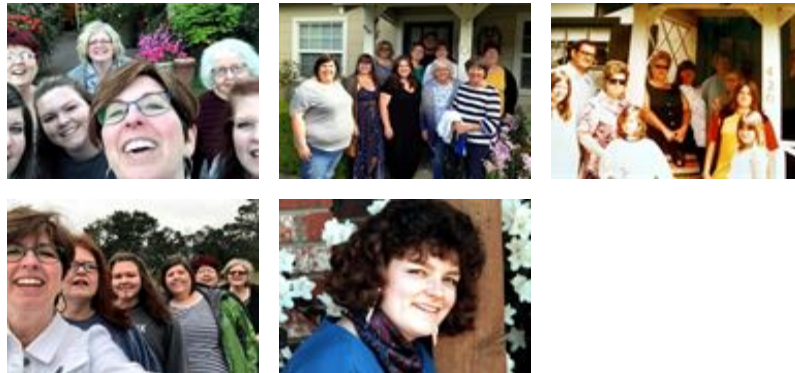

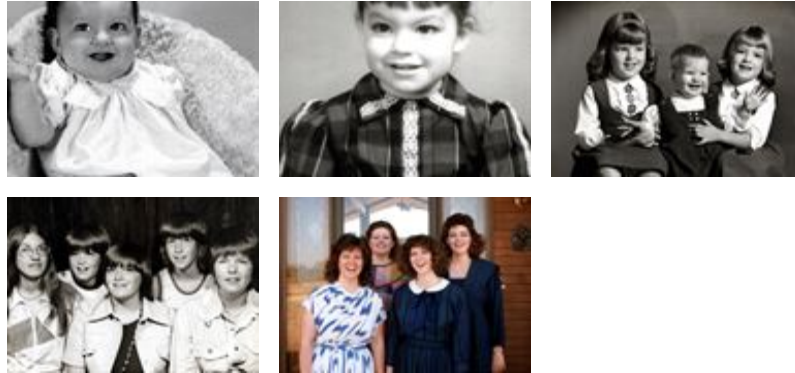
