Martha Lorraine Slack, 91 of Muskogee died Friday June 24, 2016.

Born July 5th 1924 in Vicksburg, MS, she was the oldest of 6 children born to James A Wilson and Beatrice G Wilson. After high school, Martha was trained as a photographer. She worked for several years in portrait studios in Oklahoma and Kansas. She won national awards for her photographs and had several on exhibit with the Professional Photographers Association. While operating her own portrait studio in Enid OK, Martha met and married Rex Slack on April 20, 1956. They raised 3 children and remained together until his death in 2013.

Martha is survived by her son, Jim and his wife Carol, and her grandchildren, Michael and Katie. She is also survived by her sister Marita Forman and other family members and friends. She is preceded in death by her husband E Rex Slack and her daughter Karen.
