“ Mike was a dear friend for almost 40 years. Cheryle and I were newly weds when we first met Mike and Carolyn. Our children were born during those early years in Oklahoma City. We were all young and eager for life and all its challenges.

*There was only one Mike Moore. He was unique. He was very smart. He didn't mind telling you what he thought whether you liked it or not. We had some great discussions over time involving just about every subject you could possibly imagine.*

*One of my favorite memories of Mike was when we were all in OKC. I worked for OG&E and there was a massive outage (80,000 homes) and he calls me up and asks me if we still had power. When I told him we did, he said, "Well, this is all your fault and we are bringing our babies over and will live with you until we get our power restored." It took about 3 days and the Moore's lived with us until they had power.*

*Mike had a big heart and giving spirit. He wrote a letter and gave a book to our son who suffers from PTSD. He was a loving and loyal friend who will be deeply missed.*

*I also have a great memory of Mike having no fear whatsoever of death. Why? Because as a Christian he knew where he was headed. During my last visit with him as I sat near his wheel chair he reached over and laid his hand on mine and said, "I want to go home." I take great comfort in knowing he is in a better place, a place he was longing for after all the suffering. I will miss him but I know I will see him again and I can only look forward to that day!! Rest in Peace buddy, I'll see you soon.*

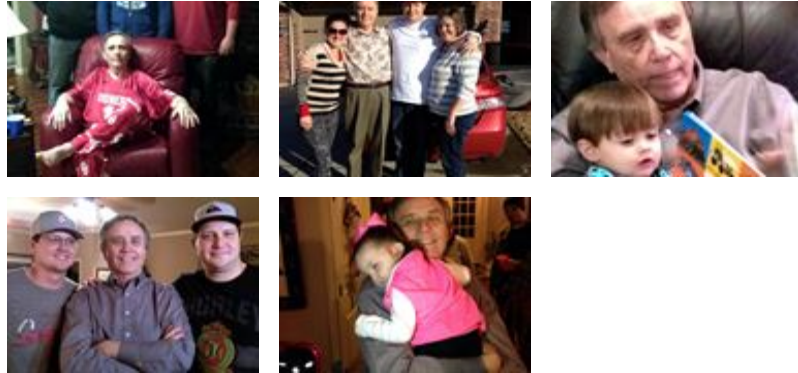
