Mina Jo Doublin, 87 of Muskogee, entered Heaven's gates Wednesday, June 15, 2016. A longtime resident of Muskogee, she was born August 29, 1928, in Sallisaw, OK to Luther and Sue (Whitsett) Standridge. At an early age, her family moved to Tulsa, OK where she attended and graduated from Daniel Webster High School.

On February 28, 1947, she married the love of her life, Billy D. Doublin. They shared over 33 years of happy marriage together. Two children were born to this union, Renee' and Rhonda.
