Montie Lee Wright, 89, of Muskogee, Oklahoma went to be with his Lord and Savior on August 1, 2021. He was born on May 27, 1932, in Muskogee, Oklahoma to Clarence Lemual Wright and Tullulah Pearl (Stevens) Wright. Montie was a faithful member and ordained Deacon of First Baptist Church, where he served on many committees, director and teacher in youth Sunday Schools and many other volunteer positions. Mission Trips with his church were important to Montie. His favorite was serving with a group known as, The Nail Benders. He was known as a “perfectionist” among his friends and family. It was said that Montie always took his own level on all the mission trips. On one trip he was on a steep roof and began sliding off when Rex Wilkinson came to his rescue by tossing him an electrical cord. His friends say he was always willing to help others.

Montie was a sports enthusiast. He enjoyed playing football in school and even allowed his sister to paint him bronze, naming him the “Bronze Body” so he could be the school’s mascot in a parade. Swimming was his favorite and the highlight his family shared was of him being in the line-up to qualify for diving team in the Olympics. Unfortunately, he was hospitalized with pneumonia for a month and missed the try outs. But Montie’s proudest swimming accomplishments were teaching his own children and grandchildren to swim as toddlers.

His grandkids’ sporting events took priority, and he was a faithful “cheerleader” and coach for every one of them; teaching them a wide variety of sports.

Montie and Faye were married 65 years. You so often heard him refer to her as “Fitzgerald” “Telling the kids Fitzgerald will take care of it”.

In his retirement years he enjoyed playing golf, especially with the group, respectfully known as “the old farts club” (Joe, John and Jim). He and Fitzgerald (Faye) also enjoyed traveling and spending time with their special friends.

After retiring from Coburn Optical and opening The Learning Ladder he became known to Schools as “Mr. Laminator Man”. As they would so many times, call The Learning Ladder asking for Mr. Laminator Man to come fix their Laminating Machines. He put thousands of miles traveling all over Oklahoma and other states delivering products and catalogs to the schools and churches.

Montie was preceded in death by his parents, Clarence and Pearl Wright, and sister, Joyce Boos.
