Mose Ray Anderson, 66, of Oktaha, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, September 15, 2015. He was born September 17, 1948 to Henry and Katie (Albert) Anderson in Wetumka, Oklahoma. Mose resided at the Jones Academy Indian Boarding School and attended public school in Hartshorne, Oklahoma where he graduated in May of 1968. He joined the U.S. Marine Corps in February of 1969 serving during the Vietnam War from September 1969 to October 1970. He received an honorable discharge in February of 1973.

Mose married the love of his life, Linda Ann Troutman on June 9, 1969 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. They shared 46 years of life and marriage together. Mose worked for Glenn Smith Oil Company where he worked in the warehouse and made deliveries. He also worked for Basolo Auto Parts. Some of Mose's favorite hobbies included fishing at the Fort Gibson Dam and rabbit hunting. He raised several beagles and trained them to come to a whistle. He also enjoyed grilling for his family.

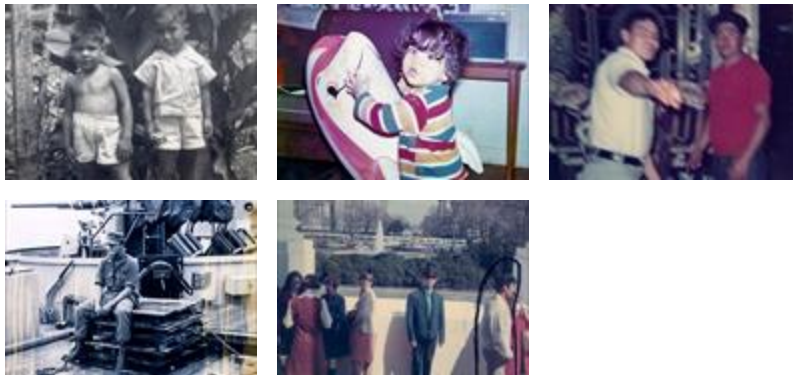


“ *To the Family of Mose,

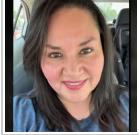
