Nolan D. Pevehouse, 87, of Webbers Falls, Oklahoma passed away on Monday, May 20, 2019. Nolan was born on December 15, 1931 to Theodore “Theo” Henry Pevehouse and Edna Marie Pevehouse-Withrow (Jones) in Wainwright, Oklahoma. He attended and graduated from Oktaha High School and then joined the Navy. He later attended Oklahoma State University and received his master’s degree in accounting to become a CPA.

Nolan worked for the IRS for more than 20 years and then retired from the BIA. He was a rancher and an avid Horse racer, he also loved to go bird hunting. His first horse was Turnpike Patty and every horse from her is also named Turnpike. He raised Painted Turnpike, who was the only triple crown winner. He won more races and money than any of the other horses. He was a 3-time world champion, and Nolan was so proud of him.

He is preceded in death by his father Theodore (Theo) Pevehouse; mother Edna Pevehouse-Withrow (Jones); and brother Carl Pevehouse, and granddaughter Misty Rogers Vaughn.
