March 25, 1923 - September 5, 2014

Pearl Sevier McCutcheon, longtime resident of Muskogee, Oklahoma, entered heaven's gates Friday, September 5, 2014 at the age of 91. She was born on March 25, 1923 at Webbers Falls, Oklahoma to John C. Sevier and Maude Kelly Sevier. Pearl graduated from Webbers Falls High School in 1939 where she was an honor student. She furthered her education by attending Bacone College where she was Valedictorian and then to Northeastern State University where she obtained her Master's Degree while carrying a 4.0 GPA. Pearl taught at Muskogee Public Schools and retired after 20 years of service. She was honored in 1988 as Teacher of the Year. After her retirement from teaching, she was active in taking care of her rental properties.

In her younger years, Pearl was an avid golfer and bowler. She served as President of the Meadowbrook Golf Association and was an active member of the Muskogee Women's Bowling Association. Pearl was inducted into the American Women's Bowling Association Hall of Fame. She also was the resident instructor at Sooner Bowl for many years where she worked with the children's leagues taking them to many district and state tournaments.

Pearl was a faithful and active member of the First Baptist Church in Muskogee where she worked in the children's ministry for many years. She remained a current member of the Co-ed class.

Pearl enjoyed crocheting. She made many afghans, bedspreads, and tablecloths. She also wrote poetry. Several of her poems were published and she was awarded honorable mention in a state contest.

Pearl will always be remembered as a wonderful wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, and the bond that held the family together. She was truly a matriarch.
