Peggy Sue Stamper, a longtime resident of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away on Friday, July 17, 2015 at the age of 68. She was born October 21, 1946 in Checotah, Oklahoma to Joe Earnest Williams and Ola Christine Davis Williams. Peggy attended Eufaula Public Schools from which she graduated. She furthered her education at Northeastern State University in Tahlequah where she obtained her Master's Degree in Education. She worked as a Special Education Teacher at Parkview School for the Blind from which she retired after many years of service.

Peggy met and later married her best friend, David Stamper, on September 22, 1972. They shared more than 39 years of life and marriage together when he passed in 2012.

Peggy was very active in Special Olympics and will always be remembered for her love of kids.

Peggy was preceded in death by her parents and her husband, David.

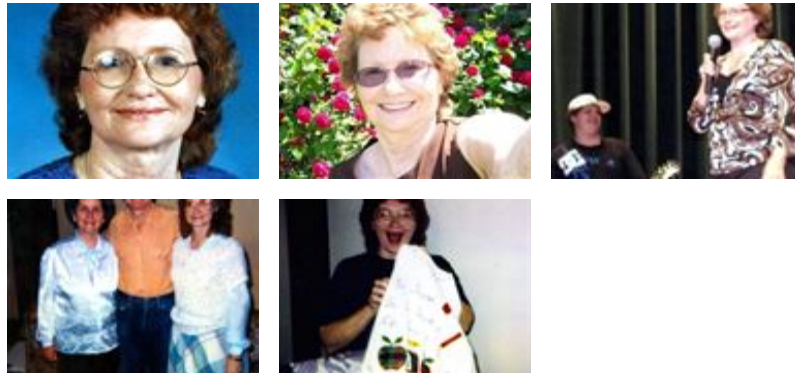
