Priscilla Parks, 87, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Saturday, October 20, 2018 with her family at her side. She was born September 1, 1931 in Dora, Missouri to Moss Landon and Thelma (Ousley) Hill. Priscilla was raised in Missouri and attended Odom, a one room school, at the age of 4. She graduated from Bakersfield High School in Bakersfield, Missouri.

Early in her life, she professed her faith being baptized at the First Christian Church in Dewey, OK.

Priscilla married the love of her life and best friend, Darrell Parks, on June 14, 1950 in Dewey, Oklahoma. They shared more than 68 years of life and marriage together. They moved many times over the years and she was active in each community they resided.

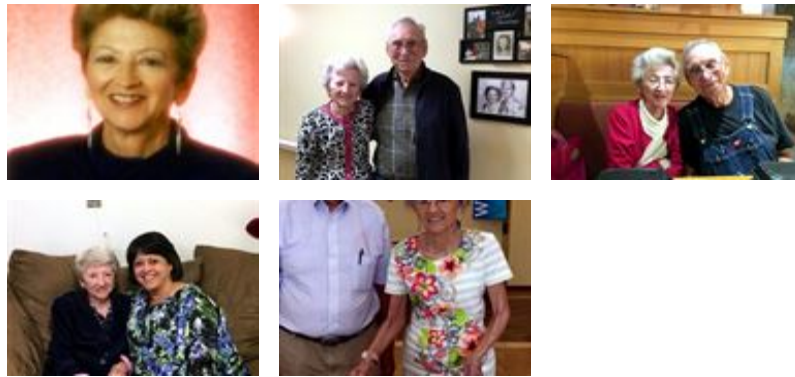
