Randall W. Richter (Randy) was born March 30th, 1962 and passed on December 4th, 2022 after a brief illness at 60 years of age. He graduated from Muskogee High School in 1980 and attended Northeastern State University. Randy made his living doing drafting and was an advanced computer aid designer. He started his career in his father's office, Roger Richter Architects Inc. of Muskogee, OK in 1982 and worked for many years there before moving on to computer drafting and design work in architectural offices in Tulsa, OK.

Randy had three passions in his life, hunting, fishing and raising cattle. He started hunting with his father at a young age and over the years was able to hunt in numerous states and other countries. He started cattle ranching in the late 80's and continued to do so until his death.
