Randall Shelton Davison, an adored father and grandfather, treasured son, beloved brother, favorite uncle, and friend to many, passed away on Sunday, December 14th, 2014 at the age of 52.

Randy was born on July 5, 1962 to Dee Shelton Davison and Evelyn Sue Malan Davison in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Randy is preceded in death by his great grandmother, Mildred Gorman Wilson and grandmother, Marion Wilson Davison. Randy is survived by his daughter, Cheyanna Rae Davison of the home and son, Ryan Shelton Davison and wife, Chelsea; and his grandchildren, Ryder Shelton Davison and Reese Ann Davison, all of Wagoner, Oklahoma .

Randy leaves his parents, Dee and Sue Davison, his only brother, Doug Davison and wife, Ronia. Randy loved teaching Ryan about hunting, shooting, fishing, archery and just about every other testosterone charged adventure they could find. Together this father and son team managed to get trucks stuck in the mud, sink boats in the river, and crash a few four wheelers, all while having the time of their lives. Randy helped coach Ryan's ball teams and enjoyed supporting all of his athletic events. These years of adventures created a bond for this father and son that will surely last in Ryan's heart forever. Randy's pride for Ryan was undeniable. In 2002 Randy married Brandy McCain, from this union Cheyanna Rae Davison was born. Cheyanna is his only daughter and absolute pride and joy. Randy loved spending time with "Chey" He was her official chauffeur for shopping trips at the mall, sleep overs with friends, taekwondo practice and the countless church events she always wanted to attend.

Randy supported Chey's school and academic events, even serving as the favorite PTO "Homeroom Mother." Randy loved Cheyanna with his whole heart and delighted in the beautiful young girl she is becoming.

Randy was an avid reader, sportsman, history buff, and absolutely loved restoring cars. His most recent automotive passion was for the Mitsubishi

3000 GT. Randy owned two GT's and spent his off time restoring and showing the Mitsubishi's at car shows. He was a member of the Oklahoma 3's Club and had many lasting friendships from their shared interests.

Randy told everyone that he had the best parents in the world. He valued their wisdom, their unyielding love of our Savior, their sense of family, and their overall goodness. He truly saw them as the shining example of living as Christ would have us to do. Randy was very proud to be their son.

Randy loved spending time with family and friends. He eagerly anticipated the holidays and all the family gatherings that they bring. Randy cleaved to tradition and relished each retelling of family stories about "the good ol' days".

Randy brought fun everywhere he went, his distinct laugh, relentless sense of humor, his unmatched energy and love have created a host of memories for everyone fortunate enough to share in his life. Randy had a way of making every single person-especially his family and close friends feel that at that moment in time they were the most important person in the world to him.
