Rebecca A. "Becky" Belt, 59, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, April 19, 2016. She was born May 28, 1956 to Donald Preston Sturgis, Sr. and June (Frazier) Sturgis in Joplin, Missouri. Becky graduated from Riverton High School with the class of 1974 in Riverton, Kansas. She then attended Pittsburg State University in Pittsburg, Kansas playing the clarinet with a major in Music.

Becky married the love of her life, Bradley Jay Belt on June 19, 1982 at the First Christian Church Disciples of Christ in Columbus, Kansas. They shared over 33 years of life and marriage together.

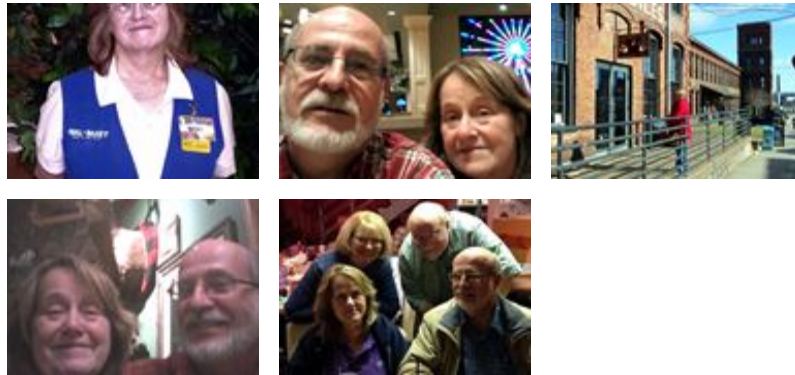
