Rhonda Noreen Frazier, 76, of Muskogee, Oklahoma entered her Heavenly eternal home on Wednesday, September 25, 2024 surrounded by her family. She was born December 24, 1947 in Wainwright, Oklahoma to A. T. and Mary Ann (Deason) Holdridge. She attended grade school at Wainwright and spent her high school years at Midway graduating in 1968. 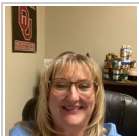
