Robert Owen Callison, III was born January 12, 1977 to Robert Owen (Bob) Callison, Jr. & Debora (Debbie) Stepp Callison in Muskogee, Oklahoma. He was lovingly welcomed by two older sisters and three older cousins who were like siblings. The only son of Bob and Debbie, and the youngest grandchild among all of his grandparents, he was destined to be spoiled. Being the third generation to carry the same Callison name - he affectionately came to be called Robbie.

As a child, Robbie was a force to be reckoned with. He was equal parts sweet and cantankerous. As most wild boys do, he loved to play outside, torment his sisters, cousins (and whatever friend or family member happened to be around) as well as break every rule he could. Robbie loved water skiing, camping, fishing and riding his three-wheeler. He had a knack for assigning the best nicknames to anyone and anything he came across. He found humor in almost any phrase that was spoken around him. He loved rock ballads and old country music. His smile and laugh were extremely contagious.

Although Robbie loved fun and adventure, he had a very hard working and responsible air about him. At age 14 he began his first of many jobs at Sequoyah Bay Marina. A short time later, he added Muskogee Skate Center and Sun Up Convenience Store to his list of jobs. Robbie balanced all of these jobs while attending school. He graduated from Muskogee High School with the class of 1996.

Soon after, he began working with his dad at the newly opened Bob's Pawn

Shop. Not one to have a shortage of jobs, Robbie began working at Georgia Pacific. He continued there for almost 20 years until he decided to make a career change and open his own Pawn Shop. After deciding that small business ownership wasn't for him, he pivoted careers once again and returned to being a machine operator. Robbie's other "job" during this time in his life was riding his motorcycle. Riding his Harley brought him freedom, clarity and peace. It was once said that four wheels moved the body, but two wheels moved the soul. This rang extremely true for Rob. Robbie passed from this life unexpectedly on September 6, 2022.

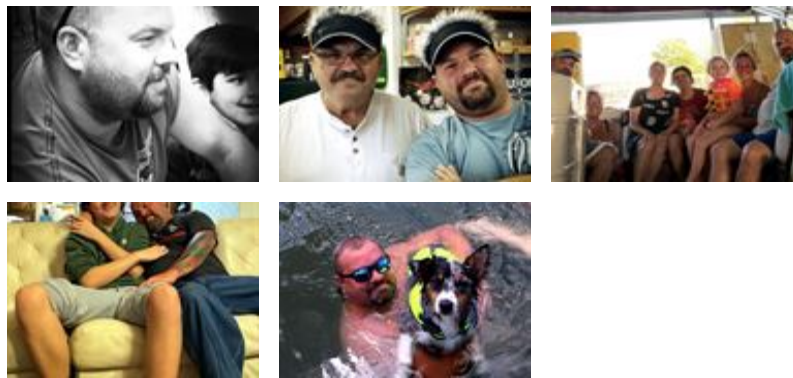

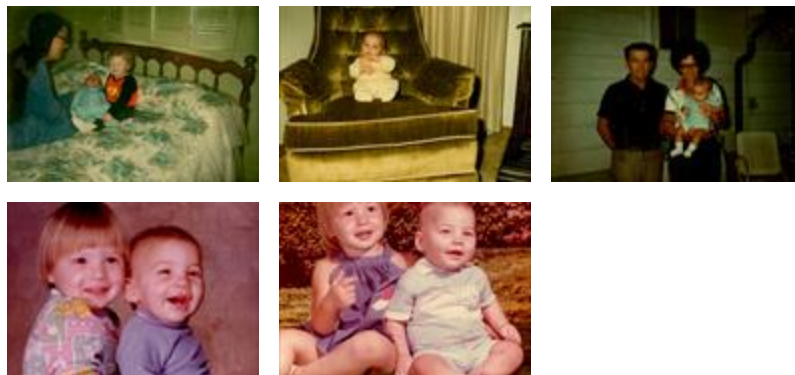
