Robert N Cooper was inducted into the United States Army on March 6, 1966. He took his basic training at the Fort Bliss Army Base, El Paso, Texas. He remained stationed at Fort Bliss to receive his Advanced Individual Training in Radar Tracking Center. He was then sent to Okinawa, Ryukyu Islands, Japan where he was trained as an Air Defense Controller and was assigned to the US Air Force with the Air Defense Artillery. Robert was honorably discharged on February 29, 1968 with a rank of SP4(T).

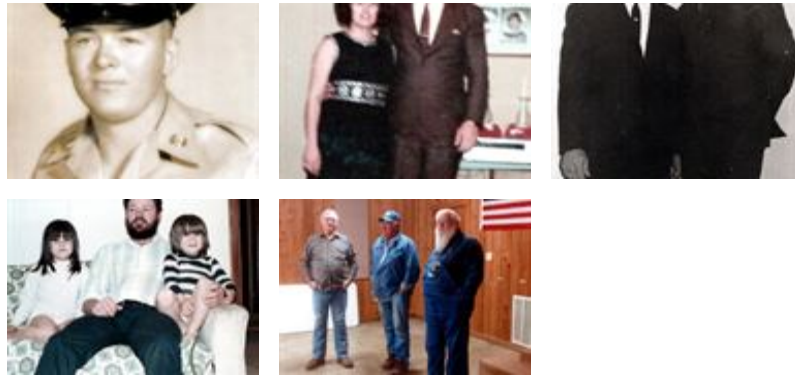
