Robert Brice Hardesty, 64, of Muskogee, passed away peacefully Wednesday evening, April 29, 2015 after a lengthy illness. He was born on July 29, 1950 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Everett Clayton and Dorothy Jeanette (Brice) Hardesty.
