Robert Louis Jackson, Sr., you probably knew him as Robbie or Papa or maybe even Senior, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family on Thursday, February 26, 2026. Robbie was born on November 28, 1953, in Silverton, Texas, to Toby Robert Jackson and Thelma Faye Clement Jackson. Robbie lived a life defined by hard work, loyalty, laughter, orneriness, and deep devotion to his family.

Robbie graduated from Muskogee High School in 1972. He built a career as the owner of Robbie's Body Shop for 30 years. Then, after years of volunteering as a reserve deputy, he elevated his dedication to service as a Muskogee County Deputy Sheriff, retiring in 2021 after 20 years of service.

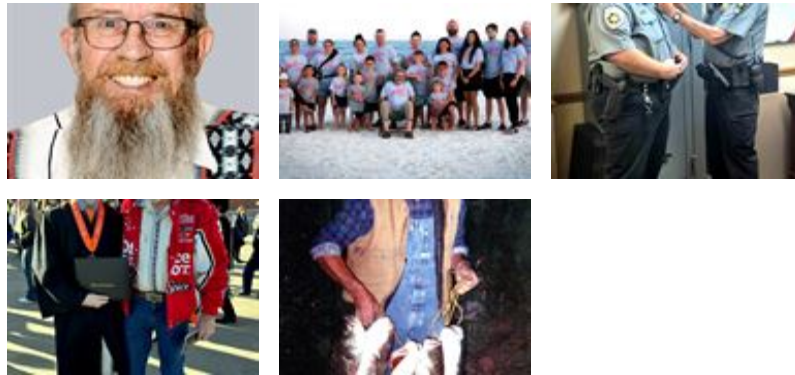
