Robert "Bob" C. Lee, 79, died on July 29, 2011. He was a devoted and loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend.

Born on June 14, 1932, Bob grew up in the small town of Branch, Ark., where he attended Branch School from 1938 to 1950. When not in school, he spent his days working the family farm.

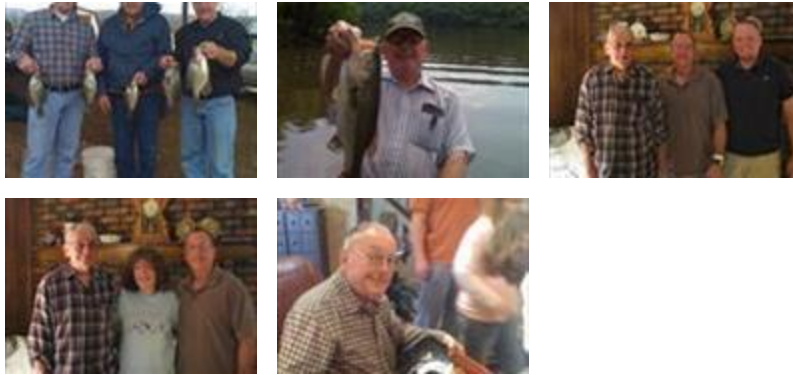
