Robert E. "Bob" Madewell, 68, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Saturday, May 19, 2018. He was born on February 7, 1950 to J.W. Madewell and Lora Sue (Rucks) Madewell in Muskogee, Oklahoma. He graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1968.

Right out of high school, Bob joined the United States Marine Corps and served in the Vietnam War. After being injured in 1969 he received a Purple Heart Medal and retired in 1971 after receiving an honorable discharge.

Bob loved his family very much and enjoyed going to the Hilldale games with his best friend, Gary Drain. He also enjoyed going hunting and fishing. Bob will always be remembered as a loving brother, father and grandfather.

He was preceded in death by his parents, J.W. and Lora Sue (Rucks) Madewell; and brother, Rick Madewell.

Bob is survived by his son, Matthew Madewell; daughter, Amanda Madewell-Moler and husband Jeremy; sister, Donna Sue Madewell; grandsons, Logan Elmore and Gabriel Moler; and other family members and friends.

He was a sweet guy and We all had lots of fun memories together. I wish I could have been at his funeral tomorrow, but I will be thinking of him.

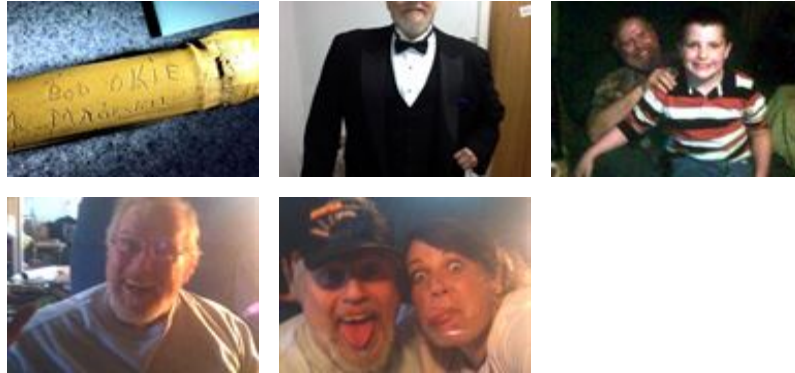
