Robert F. "Bob" Richey, age 76, was born at home in Kremlin, Oklahoma on October 31, 1940 to William A. and Mary (Taylor) Richey. He and Glenda (Feist) Richey were married on November 26, 1960 in Medford, Oklahoma. He died on August 7, 2017 in Muskogee, Oklahoma after a long illness. Bob grew up on a central Oklahoma farm and helped his family raise wheat, alfalfa and cattle. He graduated from Kremlin High School and Oklahoma A&M. He lived in Ponca City and Beggs, OK and Burkburnett and Baytown, TX while working many years for Conoco Oil Company. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church of Muskogee and the Knights of Columbus, a member of Scouting's Order of the Arrow and a former Scoutmaster.
