Roger Norton Lee, 76, of Oktaha, Oklahoma passed away on October 5, 2025. Roger was born on March 23, 1949 in Wagoner, Oklahoma to the proud parents of Winton and Betty Lee.

Roger will be remembered for his love and devotion to his family and friends as well as for his dedication to his law enforcement career.

Roger was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend to all that knew and loved him.

Roger graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1967. He joined the Muskogee Police Department in December of 1973, devoting the rest of his working career to serving his community and the Justice System. After retiring from the Muskogee Police Department in 1994, he traveled to California and worked several years in the correctional department. He then made the move back to Oklahoma where he worked for the Muskogee County Sheriffs Department. Roger finished his career after serving several years with the Federal Courthouse Security Department and finally retiring in 2019.
