



## Roger J. Phillips

July 13, 1948 - June 30, 2023

Roger Joe Phillips, 74, of Bixby, Oklahoma passed away Friday, June 30, 2023. He was born July 13, 1948 in Fort Smith, Arkansas to Carl Dempsey and Agnes Marie (Moschner) Phillips. He attended public schools and graduated from Greenwood High School with the class of 1966. He furthered his education at Westark Jr. College attending for two years before he became a member of the United States Army. Roger proudly served his country in Germany and Vietnam. After his honorable discharge from the military, he returned to college graduating from Northeastern State University in 1975 with a bachelor's degree in accounting.

Roger married Vann Carolyn Ball on August 5, 1972 in Russellville, Arkansas. They shared more than 50 years of life, marriage and memories together. Roger worked as a public accountant having his own private practice for many years. He was the controller for Lin Lar Golf Course (Cobblestone Golf Course) during its construction phase. He worked for Optronics Inc. as the accountant and controller. He finished his career at the Veterans Administration in the Veteran Education Department and retired in 2012. Roger was an avid bass fisherman and was a member of the Muskogee Bass Club for many years.

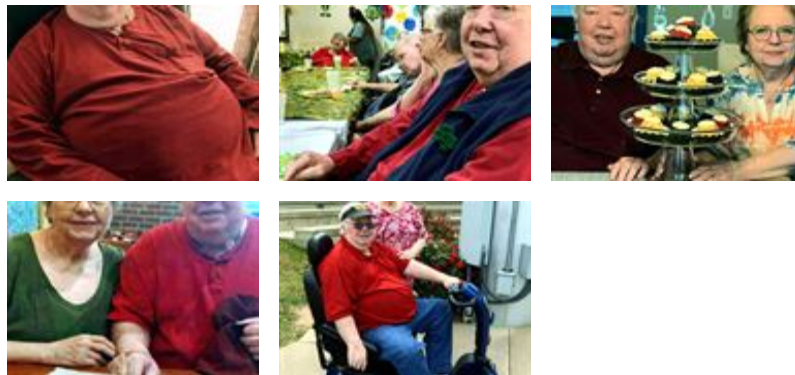
