



## Rolleen June Boling

October 26, 1940 - June 15, 2024

Rolleen June (Verge) Boling, 83 of Muskogee, Oklahoma went to her Heavenly Home on Saturday, June 15, 2024. She was born on October 26, 1940, to James Arthur Verge and Edith Marie (Vanslyke) Verge in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Her first years of life began east of Ft Gibson where she attended a one-room school called Browns School just down the road from where she lived. Her family later moved to town in Ft. Gibson, which was where she made some of her best childhood memories. At age 12 her father purchased a farm in Porter. She enjoyed playing basketball at Porter High School and graduated with the class of 1958.

After going on a blind date shortly after graduating from high school, Rolleen married the love of her life, Doyle Boling, on May 5, 1960 in Porter, Oklahoma. She attended Muskogee Community College for two years and did secretarial work until after she had her children, Ellen Amanda and then Clint Aaron. She then was a stay-at-home mother and was always a part of her kids' childhood functions.

In 1980 Doyle and Rolleen began a construction company, and she handled all the administrative part of company. This went on for the next 35 years. Rolleen was a faithful member of Grandview Baptist Church where she was a Sunday School teacher for many years. She enjoyed gardening, cooking, reading and watching movies. Rolleen will be missed by everyone who knew and loved her.

She was preceded in death by her parents, James and Edith Verge; her

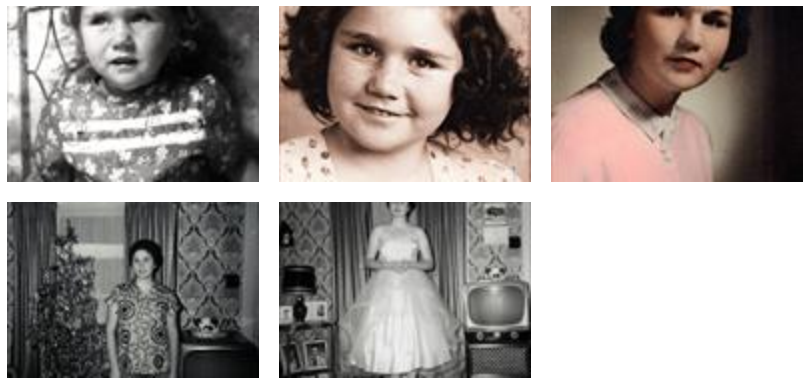
