Ron Buck Jr, 59, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, November 27, 2024. He was born on August 4, 1965 at St. Mary's Hospital in Enid, Oklahoma.

His childhood was spent in Muskogee where he attended Muskogee Schools until his graduation with the class of 1984. Ron furthered his education at Connors State College and graduated in 1987 with an associates degree. He continued his education at Northeastern State University and obtained a bachelor's degree in psychology in 1992.

Ron was employed as an outreach counselor at "McCoys", Muskogee County Council Abuse Services. He thoroughly enjoyed being with the students and getting acquainted with their families. He later worked for Advanced Warnings where he was a road construction supervisor until he became disabled in 2002. He lived for 22 years being disabled and never complained. He had such an uplifting attitude.

He was an avid OU fan. He never missed an OU football game or womens' softball games. He also enjoyed watching the Dallas Cowboys, but not when they were losing.

Ron loved playing board games, especially "Clue", because he was an

exceptional player. He also liked all card games but Hearts was his favorite. He was always a good loser as well as being a really good winner. Above all, Ron treasured the time he spent with his loved ones creating forever memories.

Ron's favorite past time was reading his Bible daily and listening to Christian music. He was a devout Christian and witnessed to everyone he came in contact with.

Ron was a member of Southeast Baptist Church.

He will be dearly missed by his family, his friends, and everyone who knew him.

Those left behind to cherish his memory are his son, Tyler Buck; his mother, Carolyn Kaiser and her husband Charles, who played a significant role in his life; his brothers, Mitch Kaiser and Mike Kaiser; his father, Wayne Buck and wife Suzie, and their son, Jonathan Buck; his sisters, Heather Buck, Jennifer Jones, Whitney Coleman, and Andrea Milligan; along with several nieces and nephews.
