Jones – Ronald R. went home to be with the Lord on March 4, 2015. He was born Sept. 23, 1954 in Muskogee, OK. He was preceded in death by his father, RB Jones.

On June 17, 1977, he married the love of his life, Sherri Dickmann. He was blessed with a son, Ron Jones and wife Veronica of Muskogee, and two daughters, Crystal Hensley and husband Jeremy of Springdale, AR, and Stephanie Morgan and husband Nik of Muskogee, and grandchildren Kiersten Jones, Easton Morgan, Jaxson Morgan and Cooper Hensley. He also leaves behind his mother, Wanda Jones of Muskogee, brothers Dean Jones of Omaha, NE and Alan Jones of Muskogee, and sister Terri Alexander of Florida as well as nephews Jared Jones and Jake Dickmann and nieces Michelle Jones and Jennifer Berryman.

He grew up on Monta as part of the Monta Gang, who will serve as his pallbearers. He graduated from Muskogee High School in 1973 and remained close to many of his classmates. After graduation, he worked as a plumber with his father, RB, and later started his own plumbing company where he welcomed Raymond Aguirre as an employee and friend.

His faith and family were foremost in his heart with Car Racing a close third. He raced late models for many years and often won at Thunderbird Speedway as well as other tracks in Oklahoma and Arkansas, often against drivers now on the Nascar circuit. He also enjoyed flying remote control airplanes, projects rebuilding cars and going on mission trips to build churches.

Services celebrating Ron's life will be 10:00 A.M., Saturday, March 7, 2015 at Muskogee First Assembly of God Church located at 3100 Gulick Street with Dr. Steve Rose and Jeremy Hensley officiating. Interment will follow at Greenhill Cemetery. Pallbearers will be Don Jones, Rick Carbone, Steve Morgan, David Johnson, Tony Maxwell, and Brad Ray. Honorary pallbearers will be Monte Humphrey and Raymond Aguirre.

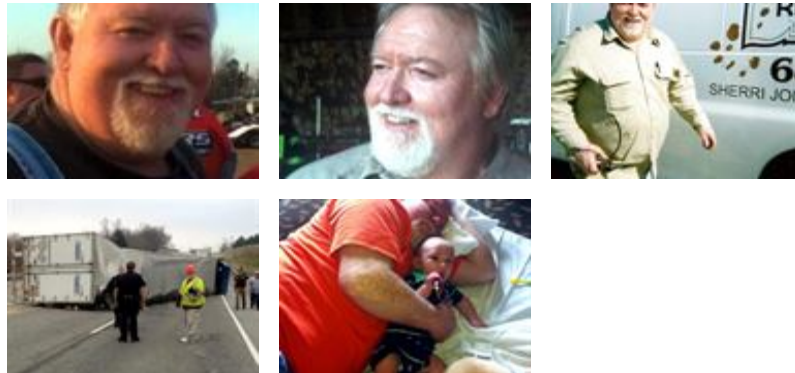
