Ronnie Kizzia, 59, passed away on Saturday, June 9, 2012 in Muskogee. He was born on November 9, 1952 to Billy G. and Beatrice R. (Williams) Kizzia. Ronnie graduated from Braggs High School in 1971 and attended Connors State College. During the course of his life he worked as a gardener for Bebb's Flowers and was an Agent for Continental Trailways in Sallisaw. The work he enjoyed the most, and what he lived for, was raising Chasity as his daughter and Savannah as his granddaughter. Chasity and Savannah were the light of his life. Ronnie loved serving the Lord and reading the Word. He could play the piano by ear and used this God-given talent by playing in church so that he and others could worship the Lord. He loved spending time with friends and family and entertained them all with his quick wit and humor. Ronnie enjoyed basketball, playing Bingo, Tater Hole, and card games with family. He especially liked watching all sports and was a very competitive athlete. His favorite teams to follow were OU and the St. Louis Cardinals. During the Larry Bird era, he was the biggest Boston Celtics fan. Ronnie often said this was the best time of his life - teaching Larry Bird how to shoot – even though "his shot was still not as good as mine". In recent years he became the biggest OKC Thunder Fan.
