Rosie Lea “Grannie” Humphrey, 91, of Muskogee, Oklahoma entered Heaven’s gates Thursday, July 20, 2017. She was born November 13, 1925 to Bud and Lee Ora (Hardt) Hall in Braggs, Oklahoma.

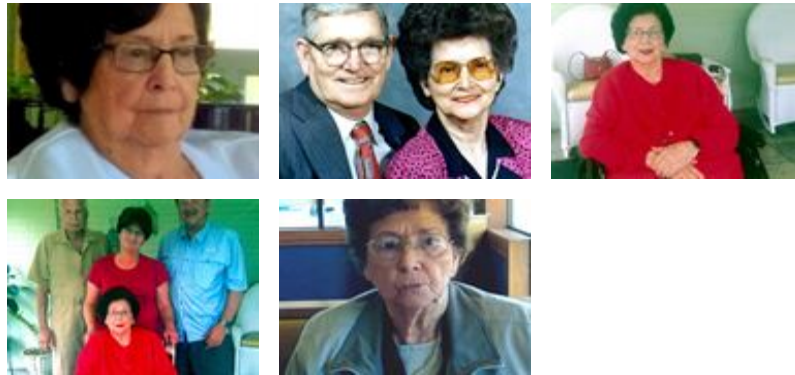

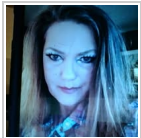

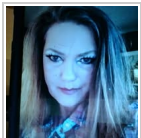
