Roxie was born in Muskogee on 16 February 1934 to Julius Howard Tillery and Nannie Sylvia [Miller] Tillery. Roxie was the 4th of 8 children. She spent her youth working with a local seamstress and as an employee of Purity Drug to help support the family. She attended Muskogee schools and graduated in the Honor Society from Muskogee Central High School in 1952.

Roxie married Alfred Martin Flusche Sr. on 23 January 1954 in the Catholic Church of the Assumption in Muskogee. After residing in Tulsa, Alfred and Roxie purchased and moved to their ranch property at 4281 South 89th Street West in 1957. They resided there together until Alfred's passing in November 2021. Thereafter Roxie was in Residence with her Godson Danny Nevitt and Team at Pleasant Valley Healthcare Center where she received loving care until her passing on Saturday, 14 May 2022.

Roxie was always a model homemaker and mother. She also worked outside the home for 24 years to support the ranch and her family goals. She held positions in accounting-bookkeeping with C E Leaird Insurance, Jones Truck Line and Muskogee County Treasurer's office. Her love of education was instrumental in both of her sons' completion of college degrees. Of course, Roxie was also the primary partner as Alfred built his cattle operation over the years. Upon retirement, she was active as a part-time employee and volunteer with the Muskogee County Election Board.

Roxie was preceded in death by her parents Julius and Nannie Tillery;

brothers Julius Jr. and Dudley Tillery; sisters Patricia and Sue Ann.
